MGB Weber to SU Carburettor Swap

My 1977 MGB had a Weber 45 DCOE side draft carburetor when I bought it less than 2 years ago. It ran fine, but typically it was hard to start and never got more than 18 mpg, usually less. I have been looking for a replacement carb, and at first I found a used DCEV courtesy of Joe's purple MGB. The car ran okay, but the low speed jet had a problem and would not idle.

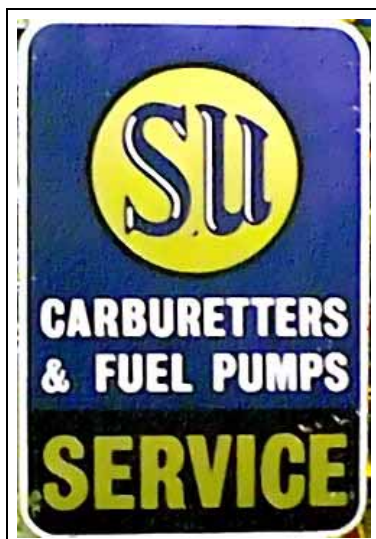

MGB Weber to SU Carb Swap (continued)

After talking to many others, my dream carbs would be a dual set of SU HS4's. I finally found a set on Craigslist in Raleigh that included heat shield, linkage, manifold, etc. The seller was even coming to the beach, and I could pick up the works at Ocean Isle.

With help from a friend, we cleaned the carbs, put in new gaskets, new springs, new fuel lines and then installed them on the car. It took a couple to 3 hours to get them synced, adjusted, chokes set, etc.



Night and day, the car has never run so good. It starts up instantly every time, idles like a fine tuned machine, and accelerates wonderfully. Plus the gas pedal feel is much better with the SU springs. Best of all the first tank I ran thru got 23 mpg. The carbs are a simple feat of engineering and easy to set up. I would recommend this conversion to anybody wanting to upgrade their car.
