# Repair or Replace? That is the Question!

For many modern cars, auto dealer labor charges can far exceed the value of a minor, or even a major, component that needs mechanical attention. And proper training for highly skilled rebuild projects may not be economically feasible, or even allowed, due to liability concerns by the subcontracting parts supplier. Therefore, auto manufacturers have specified that most components be replaced rather than repaired. Plus, replacing parts is quicker and can generate better profits with less investment in shop space and specialty tools.

Repair or Replace? (cont.)

But not every mechanical component on your old LBC will need to be replaced when it begins to under perform. If you are like me, your "shop labor time" is pretty cheap. So open up your LBC's factory repair manual and look for breakdown and rebuild instructions for what is typically a throwaway parts in today's motor world. Waterpumps, starters, alternators and generators, steering and suspension items, even windshield wiper motors and fuel pumps are very easy to refurbish. Replace electrical contacts and brushes, seals, and bearings yourself with common DIY weekend garage hand tools.

Shown above are the component parts of a fairly common part ... a drive belt idler pulley (or "jockey" pulley in Brit-speak) that retails for about \$100 plus shipping. When the pulley begins squawking, the only part that really needs to be replaced is the bearing! Why not remove the bearing and replace it for a fraction of the cost. Careful examination in the groove of the sheave reveals a small indent with an Allen headed retaining grub screw. Slacken the grub screw and press out the bearing along with the end cap seal. Check to see if your favorite Brit parts supplier offers a rebuild kit. Or in larger metro areas, take the bearing to a full range supply house where they can check for availability of a replacement. The only tool that you may not have to complete the job is an inexpensive bench press. So now is the time to make a worthwhile investment

With a bench press, press in a new bearing. Then secure the end seal with Locktite red.


