

GSBCC Meeting Minutes

August 8, 2020

After a few technology challenges President Rod Smith called the August meeting of the Grand Strand British Car Club to order at approximately 10:14 a.m. on Saturday, August 8, 2020.

VP Greg Hoch thanked everyone for wearing nametags.

Treasurer Julia Nightingale-Born inquired about the status of Britfest refund requests. Bill had sent a list on 7/29, and as of today he has not heard back from 3 of the 4. Rod will send a confirmation email to Bill requesting his donation(s) and will also check to see if there is a way to do a credit via Stripe if the registration was done with a credit card.

Minutes from the last meeting were approved as published in the GSBCC Newsletter.

Newsletter Editor Bill Unger reported that the content of the Newsletter is shallow, and Rod will write an article encouraging members to consider running for office.

Webmaster Ethan Harris reported that the website is much faster now, and he asked for notification of items to post, such as the September meeting and drives. He also suggested that others should be able to access Stripe for management changes.

Rod's President's report summarized the difficulty that the board had with the decision to postpone Britfest until 2021 and the plans for an October Mask-a-Raid drive, a November Britnic at the Pelican's Baseball Park, and the Christmas party at Wahoo's:

- Saturday, October 31 – 95-mile Mask-a-Raid Drive from 10:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. – the starting point will be Rod's house in Murrells Inlet (or anywhere along the route) to Market Common in Myrtle Beach to pay homage to the Britfest site to Dunkin Donuts at Carolina Forest to lunch at Allsbrook Grocery & Grill to the old Esso Station at Galivants' Ferry to Conway, ending at the Bonfire Taqueria for a Black & Tan (or Julia's house) – check the website and the Newsletter for more details, and, of course, costumes are optional, but a mask is required
- Saturday, November 21 – Britnic at the Pelicans' Park in Myrtle Beach with us – park your British car at an appropriate social distance on the Pelicans' outfield – Ray Maggio has arranged with the Pelicans' manager to open the concession stands for our Britnic – we will invite Wilmington, Charleston and Columbia clubs to join us for what may just become an annual event
- Tuesday, December 1 – Christmas party at Wahoo's

A Nominating Committee will be appointed next month.

The next meeting will be held via Zoom on Saturday, 9/12 at 1:30 p.m.

Rod closed the meeting at approximately 10:45 a.m.
